## KUCH'S KORNER

This week, Kuch's Korner is devoted to football. Saturday, the Jr. Bills open their 1973 season with a 2 pm game against McCluer at Ferguson Jr. High. This year's offense has potential as a high scoring machine with coach Martel's multiple offenses including the Wishbone T, a Houston pro set, and I formations. However, the offense led by QB Mike Detwiler, running backs John Iovaldi and Kent Miller, with John Cosgrove and Greg Mayhew at ends must contend with the "52 corner" defense of McCluer-- a five man line, two line-backers and four defensive backs. Look for SLUH to run quick openers up the middle, sweeps, and the old option combined with swing-passes on the outside. The object, as it looks now, is to outmuscle them in the middle or outrun them outside. The defense led by the front wall of Matecki, Benz, DeZern, Mayhew, and Jolley will have to contend with the I-slot offense of McCluer. The I-slot is used mainly for power running and wide open passings, either of which will put pressure on our 40 (four man front) or 60 (six man front) defense. If last year was any indication, the defense should be excellent, for the JV team allowed only one touchdown in five games. In the pro ranks, Don Coryel leads his wide-open St. Louis Cardinals against the Philadelphia Eagles
