#### Drop off and collection:

**Drop-off:** To support parents and carers in arriving earlier than the allocated drop off times we will continue to open the doors to your child's allocated bubble 5 minutes before the allocated time provided. This is in an attempt to reduce any significant queueing.

#### Collection:

1. Parents are politely requested to collect as near to the allocated finish time as possible. This is to support the children's learning and prevent large numbers arriving at once.

2. Please can parent and carers notify staff in your child's bubble of the person collecting your child, if it is not yourselves. Academy staff, will note release your child out of care without this parental consent.
