

**Mooresville Graded School District Board of Education
Electronic Virtual Regular Monthly Meeting, Tuesday, May 12, 2020, 9:00 a.m.**

The May 12, 2020, approved meeting minutes have been amended to include the contract recommendations.

The Board of Education of the Mooresville Graded School District met in an electronic virtual regular monthly session on Tuesday, May 12, 2020.

Virtually present were Mr. Roger Hyatt, Chairman; Mr. Greg Whitfield, Vice Chairman; Mr. Leon Pridgen; Dr. Debbie Marsh; and Mrs. Kerry Pennell.

Superintendent Dr. Stephen Mauney and Mark Childers were virtually present. Mrs. Terry Haas, Chief Finance Officer; Dr. Todd Black, Assistant Superintendent for Secondary Instruction and CTE; Dr. Scott Smith, Assistant Superintendent for Elementary Instruction and Technology; Dr. Ingrid Medlock, Assistant Superintendent for Human Resources; Dr. Michael Royal, Chief Operations Officer; and Mrs. Tanae McLean, Chief Communications Officer, were virtually present.

Mr. Hyatt called the meeting to order, shared the importance of thanking and honoring the important people in our lives not only once a year, but every day. He held a moment of silence and introduced Prek-4 student Elizabeth Royal who led the Pledge of Allegiance.

Public Comment: None

Dr. Mauney requested to amend the meeting Agenda removing **Item IX; Approval of the 2020-2021 Calendar Changes**. Dr. Mauney advised the new calendar legislation is quite complicated and there are still numerous questions related to its interpretation. He feels the district needs to gather additional & further information from district stakeholders and review different options before requesting board approval of the 2020-2021 calendar changes as mandated by the General Assembly. He also stated the 2019-2020 MGSD calendar was extremely successful and said school officials will continue to press for local control of its calendar. **On a motion by Mr. Whitfield, seconded by Dr. Marsh, the board voted unanimously to approve the amended meeting agenda as presented.**

On a motion by Mrs. Pennell, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to approve the minutes of the April 14, 2020, electronic virtual regular meeting as presented.

The next school board meeting will be held electronically on Tuesday, June 9, 2020, at 9:00 a.m.

Staff Reports:

- a) **Facilities and Construction Report:** Dr. Royal advised that an interview panel made up of MHS administrators, coaches, teachers, and parent representatives recently held multiple rounds of panel interviews for the MHS head football and head boys basketball coach vacancies. Recommendations for both positions will be brought to the board for approval during the closed session. Dr. Royal reported that he and the district level team have virtually met and interviewed general contractors and architecture firms regarding upcoming district projects and are now in the process of checking references and negotiating contracts. He will bring contracts for board approval at the June 9, 2020, board meeting. He shared that the MHS Class of 2020, are being honored and celebrated with "Friday Night Lights" at the MHS Football Stadium. Every Friday night at 8:20 p.m. (20:20 military time), the stadium lights are turned on for 20 minutes. Friday Night Lights began on May 2, 2020 and will continue until May 22, 2020. Dr. Royal shared that the district will not be holding the annual MGSD Operations Awards Ceremony but the district is compiling videos/slideshows to honor and recognize our MGSD Operations Staff winners. The winners will be announced virtually on May 22, 2020. Dr. Royal shared custodians are over 50% complete in deep cleaning and preparing the facilities for the 2020-2021 school year.

- b) **Instructional Report:** Dr. Smith advised that due to COVID-19 the district has made the decision to allow students to keep their laptops throughout the summer. At this time, MHS seniors have returned their laptops and equipment. He thanked the technology staff for their diligence and hard work in supporting our students and staff during virtual learning. Dr. Smith explained that virtual learning is going well and MGSD is in a fortunate place to be ahead and successful with our virtual learning. He reported that this was the last week for K-6 instruction and explained the state guidelines and requirements on how to handle grades for students in K-6. Students in K-6 will not receive a final grade or report card but will receive a Teacher Feedback Form that will list the students progress during the 4th quarter. Dr. Smith shared K-6 teachers are planning transitional meetings where each grade level will identify student gaps and teams will be working together to figure out how to transition their students. He advised that 4th grade students identified and placed in the AIG program will be tested within the first 10-days of the start of the 2020-2021 school year. Summer school plans are due soon to the Department of Public Instruction (DPI), but the District will have to verify state funding before planning the K-6 summer program. Dr. Smith shared that if the COVID-19 state restrictions are not lifted, he expects the District will offer virtual summer school. Lastly, Dr. Smith advised that teachers will be allowed access to their classrooms this week to retrieve items and plans are underway to allow school access for students to retrieve their classroom items. Dr. Black shared that MHS held a unique senior drop-off event at Blue Devil Blvd. to collect

student laptops/equipment and distribute their caps and gowns. This event went well and was extremely organized. A similar drop-off collection event will be held for MHS underclassmen and at Mooresville Middle School. Dr. Black explained the state instructions, guidelines, and requirements for grading students in grades 7-8. Students at Mooresville Middle School will receive either a pass code or a withdrawal code. If MMS students were failing a course on March 13, 2020, they will receive the WC19 code but will hopefully have the opportunity to attend summer school to make up work and receive a pass code. The last day for instruction at MMS will be held on May 15, 2020. Dr. Black shared state instructions, requirements, & guidelines for grading MHS students in grades 9-11. Parents and students in grades 9-11 have been informed and given instructions regarding the grading options provided by the state and in choosing the final grade that will be listed on their transcripts. Grading choices include; Q3 final grade or Q3/Q4 Average, PC19 or WC 19. Dr. Black advised summer school discussions are underway for MMS & MHS but will be dependent on state funding. He shared plans are underway for meetings between 6th and 7th grade teachers, and 8th & 9th grade teachers to discuss student gaps, resources, and to guide the transition and help cater the individual needs of the students.

- c) **Business Services Report:** Mrs. Haas shared that the district is continuing to monitor funding from the General Assembly that is needed to provide students with services, program implementations, and to begin planning and preparing for the 2020-2021 school year. At this time the only funding we can begin using are the funds passed down from Governor Cooper. Additional state funding is expected from the General Assembly however, it is unclear as to when, the amount of funding, the funding allocations, and restrictions. Until we receive information from the state we will need to continue to monitor these funds which is critical in order to provide & implement services to our students. Mrs. Haas advised the district is in the process of closing out the 2019-2020 school year and is looking forward to receiving the funding from the General Assembly to begin preparations for the 2020-2021 school year. Mrs. Haas gave a shout out to the School Nutrition Dept. and the Transportation staff for their wonderful job in providing and delivering over 800 meals to our students through our bus delivery program.
- d) **Human Resources Report:** Dr. Medlock advised that Teacher of the Year (TOY) interviews were held last week and thanked the panel of judges for their participation in the interview process. The Beginning Teacher of the Year (BTOY) interviews will be held next week and the BTOY & TOY winners will be announced at the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. Dr. Medlock shared the teacher licensure changes due to COVID-19, and explained that the state has not yet opened the teacher licensure renewal window but has extended the renewal process until June 2021. She will keep the teachers

posted. Dr. Medlock gave a shout out to Principals who have done a great job interviewing and hiring new candidates. She anticipates MGSD will start the 2020-2021 school year with no vacancies. She shared that MGSD currently has 30 unemployment claims at this time but claims have begun to slow down.

- e) **Public Communications Report:** Mrs. McLean shared COVID-19 has caused changes to the School Calendar laws and stated she has been receiving a lot of feedback from parents regarding these calendar changes. She indicated she is currently reviewing the new Title IX regulations and is waiting for guidance from the NCSBA. Mrs. McLean stated she will be holding a parent teacher advisory virtual meeting later today and is excited to get their feedback. She shared that the Carolina Panthers have expressed interest in doing something special to honor the North Carolina & South Carolina senior Class of 2020. She will keep the board posted on those plans.

- f) **Superintendent's Report:** Dr. Mauney advised that he never anticipated the challenges the District would face during the COVID-19 pandemic but is extremely proud of the MGSD administrators, teachers, and support staff for their hard work and in meeting the needs of our students during this difficult time. He shared that our district is in the final weeks of the 2019-2020 school year and everyone is still going above and beyond the call of duty. Dr. Mauney thanked the Executive Team for their leadership and support. He shared that although our district is still facing many unknowns and uncertainties regarding graduation, sports, beginning of next school year, etc. He assures the board, parents, and the community that the district is constantly meeting, discussing, and communicating with stakeholders, and the General Assembly. In addition Dr. Mauney stated that he has also been in constant communication with elected officials, superintendents throughout the state, DPI and other North Carolina agencies for guidance in putting plans in place to keep our staff, students, and families safe.

- g) **Board Events and Announcements:** None

Approval of Appointment to Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees: Dr. Mauney presented Mrs. Leigh Whitfield for reappointment to the Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees. **On a motion by Dr. Marsh, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to reappoint Mrs. Leigh Whitfield to a four-year term on the Mitchell Community College Board of Trustees.** Board Vice Chairman Mr. Whitfield recused himself from voting on this item.

Approval of School Nutrition Bids: Mrs. Haas presented and explained the recommended 2020-2021 school nutrition bids. **On a motion by Mr. Whitfield, seconded by Mrs. Pennell, the board voted unanimously to approve the School Nutrition Bids as presented.**

Approval of Budget Amendment: Mrs. Haas presented and explained the capital outlay budget amendment for the fiscal year ending on June 30, 2020. **On a motion by Mr. Pridgen, seconded by Dr. Marsh, the board voted unanimously to approve the Budget Amendment as presented.**

Approval of Supplemental Tax Rate: Mrs. Haas presented the 2020-2021 supplemental tax rate at the same rate as the previous year. The supplemental tax rate for the Mooresville Graded School District will remain at 18.5 cents per \$100.00 assessment. **On a motion by Mrs. Pennell, seconded by Dr. Marsh, the board voted unanimously to approve the 2020-2021 Supplemental Tax Rate as presented.**

Mr. Hyatt, under G.S. §143-318.11 (a)(1), (a)(6), & (a)(3), announced the board would go into closed session to present the disclosure of information that is privileged or confidential, review personnel, and consult with the board attorney. **On a motion by Mr. Whitfield, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to go into closed session.**

On a motion by Dr. Marsh, seconded by Mr. Whitfield, the board voted unanimously to adjourn from closed session.

On a motion by Mrs. Pennell, seconded by Mr. Pridgen, the board voted unanimously to approve the personnel list as recommended by the Superintendent.
