## General Information

In accordance with the Education Code Section 51747, I grant permission for the above-named student to enroll in Virtual Academy, which is an optional alternative education strategy in the Academies of the Antelope Valley.

In accordance with Education Code Section 5174 7, and Board Policy 6158, I understand that for the above-named student:

- a. This agreement is valid for not more than one semester.
- b. Enrollment is an optional educational alternative in which no student may be required to participate. The option of a regular classroom instructional program at the student's school of residence will always be available. A student, whose expulsion has. Been suspended, pursuant to E. Code Section 48915 or 48917, may pursue Independent Study only if the student has been offered the alternative of classroom instruction by the district.
- c. The manner of instruction used is an individualized, student-teacher strategy.
- d. District policy provides that no more than three weeks may elapse between the date on which an assignment is made and the date on which it is due, unless the period is officially extended.
- e. Board Policy 6158 provides that an accumulation of four missed assignments will result in an evaluation of whether or not the student will be allowed to continue in Independent Study. A written record of this evaluation shall be maintained in the student's permanent record.
- f. This agreement will remain intact unless modified with approval from the parent, student and teacher.

**School attendance is a student/parent responsibility. In the Virtual Academy, the attendance requirement is satisfied only by completion of assigned work.** Academic credit is separate from attendance credit. Academic credit is awarded by the instructor based upon the completeness of the student's work and his/her performance on evaluative instruments designed for each unit of study within a specific subject.

## PARENT RESPONSIBILITIES

It is my/our responsibility to provide the support needed so that the above named student can maintain progress toward the achievement of a high school diploma.

This will require at least that I/we will:

- a. Make certain that assignments are completed.
- b. Make necessary arrangements for transportation.
- c. Be responsible to see that the student is in attendance for his/her scheduled time.
- d. Provide an environment that supports achievement.

## STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

I will:

- a. Strive for perfect attendance at all scheduled appointments and complete all work as agreed upon.
- b. Provide the necessary evidence that I have fulfilled work assignments.
- c. Complete assignments per the pacing guide **or** agreement with the instructor.
- d. Abide by all the conditions of the student contract.

## SCHOOL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- a. The teachers will evaluate the work presented by the student under the terms of the Virtual Academy Agreement to determine the credit earned by the student. All home work will be checked for completion.
- b. The teachers will offer guidance and provide resources to the student as specified in each course contract or assignment.
- c. The teachers will re-evaluate the student's placement in the Virtual Academy at the end of the semester.
- d. Each principal shall make available to all Virtual Academy students all school activities for which they meet eligibility requirements.
