CATAWBA County Schools

> The governor decides which state plan we operate under - Plan A, B, or C. Last week, he announced that all NC Public Schools would begin on August 17 under Plan B, a mix of in-person and online learning.

Important: Depending on the COVID-19 metrics, the governor could change plans during the school year. Therefore, the "A/B/C Plan" requires your family to be flexible when/if we transition between plans.

100% online, 100% flexible, 100% consistent, 100% free⁺

For families who would prefer a 100% remote option, you may choose our Online Catawba K-12 Virtual Learning Academy. Since 2017-18, we have been educating students remotely with over 1,000 students enrolled last year.

- Available for all students Kindergarten 12th grade
- Students remain enrolled in their "base school" for access to special programs such as athletics, band, and more (when these programs are permitted to reopen)
- Classes taught by CCS teachers dedicated to Online Catawba
- Flexible learning environment with real-time and pre-recorded video options so students learn at their own pace, on their own time
- Face-to-face tutoring available during office hours, if needed
- K-8 Curriculum: Reading, math, science and social studies
- **9-12 Curriculum**: Course enrollments based on individual student needs. Students work with counselors for course selection
- All materials normally supplied to traditional students are provided, including Chromebooks, textbooks, workbooks, etc.
- Courses in grades K-8 are year-long, while courses in grades 9-12 are semester-based.
