## Fast Facts

- Elmbrook offers 26 different Advanced Placement courses and is consistently ranked in the top ten across the state for ACT performance and participation data.
- Both high schools are recognized for their depth of co-curricular offerings, outstanding accomplishments at the team and individual levels, and commitment to community service through active clubs and organizations.
- Brookfield Central boasts the largest Key Club in the world with over 500 students performing 9,000 hours of community service.
- Families choose Elmbrook from all over the world. There is a 35% non-white student body, and students speak over 40 languages at home.
- Elmbrook offers a high quality arts program through a community partnership with the Sharon Lynne Wilson Center for the Arts.
- The LAUNCH program offers high school students the opportunity to participate in personalized learning experiences through a partnership with local businesses.
- Elmbrook offers employees a Family Wellness Clinic with self-funded insurance and reduced \$3 million in health care costs over 4 years without increasing costs to employees while expanding benefits.
