Health and Safety and Related Planning Details

As of July 20, 2020

In accordance with requirements set forth by the Pennsylvania Department of Education, the School District of Haverford Township School Board of Directors will vote on a Health and Safety Plan prior to the reopening of schools. This vote will occur during the July 30, 2020 school board meeting.

This plan is divided into four categories: Distancing, Screening, Hygiene, Masking.

In order to provide our community with a sense of what the school experience will be like for students, our principals have provided brief descriptions of their plans to implement the Health and Safety guidance at this time.

As always, these plans remain fluid as guidance, direction, and trajectory of the virus continue to change. The District continues to seek clarity and direction from officials on a number of issues.

More detailed information regarding schedules, expectations, and procedures will be shared in the coming weeks.

It's understood that parents'/guardians' feelings and concerns about how to safely open schools are very strong and vary widely. No one plan will satisfy everyone's concerns. We've done the best we can to offer options and will work to make the school year as safe and positive as possible.
