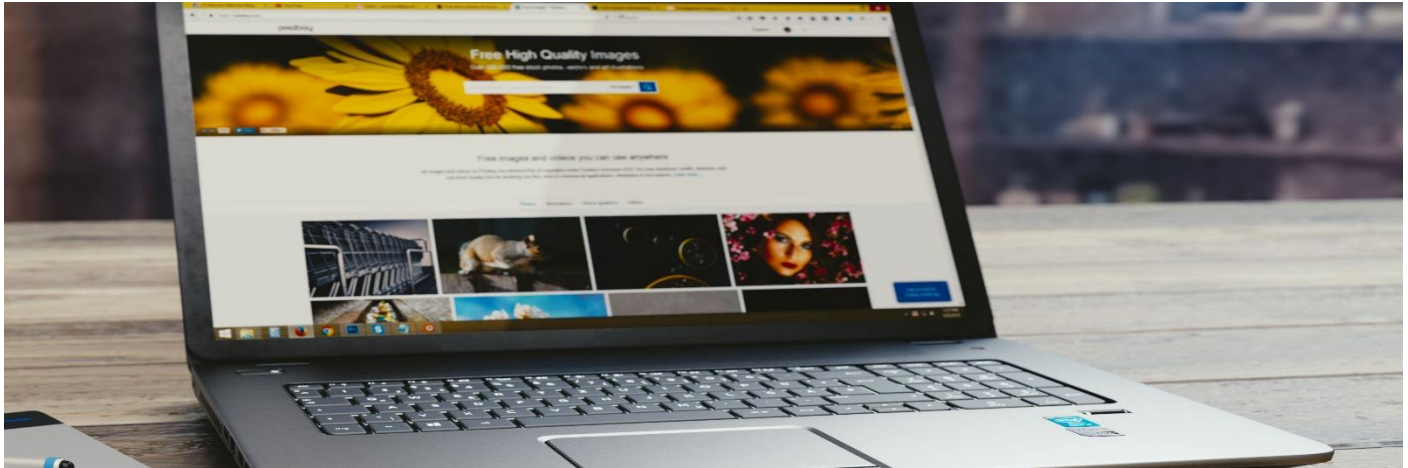


IV. ONLINE ACADEMICS

ONLINE ACADEMICS



Parents and students who desire to take an online course for original credit must be informed that:

- The student will take an online course through Edgenuity, Texas Virtual School Network, or Connections Learning.
- The student will not be concurrently enrolled in more than two (2) courses at one time.
- The school district that provides the course through Texas Virtual School Network determines the start and end dates.
- An online course is extremely rigorous.
- The course will require the student to work outside of school time.
- Completing the course will require the student to have access to a computer with internet at home.
- Once enrolled in an online course, the student's schedule will not be changed and the course will not be dropped.
- It is the student's responsibility to complete the course within the scheduled timeline.
- The student is responsible for logging into his/her course daily and completing all assignments on time.
- The course grade will become part of the student's transcript and count towards the student's overall GPA.
- The student must complete assignments during the holidays in order to maintain pace with the course.

Enrollment

A student may enroll in an online course for original credit through Edgenuity, Texas Virtual School Network, or Connections Learning if:

1. There is a conflict with other classes in the student's schedule, or
2. A course is not offered on the student's home campus, and
3. The online course fits within a student's 8-period schedule, and
4. The principal or designee approves the enrollment.

Campus Dropout Prevention

A student may enroll in the campus dropout prevention program if:

1. The student is at least 3 credits behind and/or in jeopardy of not graduating with his or her cohort
2. The student is able to earn/recover at least 1 credit within a timeframe specified by the campus.
3. The principal or designee approves the enrollment.

Students enrolled in online classes are assigned to an in person class with a teacher who monitors progress and serves as a liaison. Due to enrollment requirements your campus counselor will approve or provide access to course offerings.
