Athletic Event Guidelines

The Sun Prairie Area School District's Athletic Department has updated guidelines related to the expectations placed upon attendees of its home athletic events. Information regarding policies concerning bags, carry-ins, fan behavior, and tickets are outlined below.

Sun Prairie High Schools and the WIAA require good sportsmanship at education-based sporting events. Attendance at interscholastic activities is a privilege with the expectation to exhibit positive and respectful behavior. For the enjoyment and respect of all in attendance, your cooperation in demonstrating the high ideals of sportsmanship is expected and greatly appreciated.

ITEMS PERMITTED:

Bags no larger than $4.5" \times 6.5"$, clear tote (12" x 6" x 12"), 1 gallon clear plastic storage bag, binoculars (without case), cameras (lenses no longer than 4"), blankets, jackets, items related to a medical condition, seat cushions (not more than 16" wide), and diaper bags (with child).

Halloween costumes must be able to fit into a normal seating space and must be appropriate. No additional carry-ins are allowed as part of a costume.

ITEMS PROHIBITED (INCLUDING, BUT NOT LIMITED TO):

Bags larger than 4.5" x 6.5" (including purses, backpacks, camera bags, drawstring bags, fanny packs and binocular cases), food, beverages, containers, laser pointers, noisemakers, weapons, inflatables, or any items deemed dangerous or inappropriate.



Any spectator carrying a prohibited item may be refused admittance or may be ejected from the venue.
