I wanted to connect quickly and share a few reminders:

- There will be no school for students this week, March 23-27. Think of this time as an extra week of spring break.
- Teachers and staff will begin tomorrow—March 23 through March 27— to prepare for online distance learning that will begin March 30. Students will be starting online learning on March 30.

Technology needs

As we prepare for online distance learning on March 30, if you are in need of technology (Chromebooks and/or internet access), **please complete this Google Form** and you will be directed to a link with an appointment scheduler. Technology pick-up times will be during the week of March 23-27, at the St. Anthony Village High School front entrance. All Chromebooks will be sanitized before provided to families.

Grab-and-go meals

Grab-and-go meals are available to children ages 18 and under, March 23-27. Children must be present at pick-up at the following locations:

- Wilshire Park front entrance: 3600 Highcrest Rd.
- St. Anthony Village High School, front entrance: 3303 33rd Ave NE.
- Windom Park parking lot: 2251 NE Hayes St.
- Windsor Green Office parking lot: 270 Windsor Ln.

If you do not have the ability to pick-up meals and/or technology, please call 612-706-1001 to arrange for delivery.

Emergency child care

St. Anthony Community Services is providing emergency care to children ages 33 months to 12 years whose parents are employed in occupations critical to the state's response to the coronavirus (COVID -19) pandemic. Follow these steps to register your child:

1. **Determine if you qualify: List of occupations which qualify families for emergency child care.** (Updated March 18, 2020 to include Tier 1 and Tier 2 workers.)
2. **If you qualify:**
 - **Step one:** upload verification: School districts must verify that parents/guardians are employed in occupations that are critical to the state's response to COVID-19. **Upload a letter from your employer and/or an image of your employment identification badge.**
 - **Step two:** register your child: **Families must register their children with Community Services.** The fee for emergency child care is \$22 a day and includes breakfast, lunch, and a snack. Emergency child care is free from 9 a.m.-3:30 p.m. (Wilshire Park school hours). Families must pay for care provided before 9 a.m., or after 3:30 p.m. Call 612-706-1166 if you need help with registration.
 - **Once registered, you will receive a confirmation email** that includes a code to gain access to the area of the building where care will be provided.
 - Care will be provided at St. Anthony Community Services, located at 3301 Silver Lake Rd.
 - To abide by social distancing measures, your children will be divided by age group into classrooms with a total of 10 students and one staff member.

Thank you for your continued patience and understanding as we share information with you. We will continue to keep you updated on any changes or direction received from the Minnesota Department of Education and/or Gov. Walz.
