School Minibus Driver

Job Description

The School Minibus Driver will be working under the direction of the Estates Manager to safely drive and support the maintenance and cleaning of School's minibuses. S/he will be driving the school bus routes in the morning and early evening and may be driving pupils to matches on Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays (afternoon only). As well as the specific duties outlined below, there is also scope for some role in other areas of school life if this would be of interest. The Minibus Driver should be in sympathy with the ethos and aims of Aldro.

Main duties

- Safe transportation of pupils to School in the morning and home in the evening via agreed pick up points
- Safe transportation of pupils to Sporting fixtures or other events being held away from School, as per weekly transport sheet issued by the Estates manager
- To carry out first use checks daily for any vehicle to be driven; to complete either a NIL defect sheet or report any defects found before driving any vehicle off site
- To report any defects which appear whilst driving as soon as it is safe to do so, and record in the off-site defect duplicate book
- To ensure the vehicle is kept fuelled, and clean; to ensure all receipts are handed into the Estates office within one week of purchase
- To report any incidents involving the vehicle or passengers immediately to the Estates Manager
- To report any problems with the children during the journey to the Estates Manager
- To ensure appropriate use of tachograph (if applicable)
- To promote and safeguard the welfare of pupils during the journey and at the School

- Mornings 6:30 a.m. to 9.00 a.m.
- Afternoons 5:30 p.m. to 7p.m.
- Ocassional Wednesdays, Thursdays and Saturdays timetable will be published by the Estates Manager, which may be subject to change depending upon fixtures (likely to be from 1pm)
