## **Holmdel High School Medical Alert - July 22, 2020**

### **Office of the Superintendent of Schools**

Today we were alerted to the possibility that a student member of the Field Hockey team, who participated in an out-of-District team workout yesterday, may have been exposed to COVID-19 at an earlier date. This potential exposure took place off-campus. This has not been confirmed, and will not be confirmed for the next few days, while we are awaiting test results. The student has been instructed to remain under quarantine until medical authorities have determined if the student has tested positive for COVID-19. If we are notified of a positive test result, we will advise you of any additional precautions.

For now, after consulting with the Department of Health and our District Physician, we are advising you to please have your child(ren) self-monitor: observe your child(ren) over the next few days for any of the common symptoms of COVID-19 including fever, cough, headaches, body aches, shortness of breath, or lung infection. If you have any questions or concerns, please contact your health care provider for additional information.

In addition, every member of the Field Hockey team who attended yesterday's workout should self-monitor and be vigilant checking for symptoms for the next 72 hours.

Although it is not required by the NJSIAA or the CDC, out of an abundance of caution we are closing the Complex to all students for the remainder of this week and canceling our summer workout scheduled for Thursday, July 23rd to limit possible exposure and to thoroughly clean the High School.

The Holmdel Township School District along with the NJSIAA COVID-19 Task Force has worked extremely hard to provide an environment that is safe and well-monitored for our student athletes. We will continue to ensure all the outlined procedures are followed and continue to provide a safe environment for your children to participate in athletics. Please don't hesitate to reach out if there is anything we can assist with at this time. We will share additional information with the Holmdel High School community by the close of the day Friday, July 24th.
