### Too Bad Elephants Can't Fly

The elephant exercise schedule has expanded from just 30 minutes a day. They will now take a 25 minute guided walk in the morning, a 35 minute guided walk in the afternoon, and a 45 minute guided walk in the evening. How much EXTRA exercise will they be receiving?



Elephants guided walk time is  $25+35+45=105$  minutes.  
Elephants walk expanded from 30 minutes so,  $105-30=75$   
Elephants receiving 75 more minutes walk

### Lions and Tiger and Trails, Oh My!

The lions and tigers are kept separated, but at different times during the day, they share a trail area. The lions have access to the trail for 35 minutes in the morning, 65 minutes in the afternoon, and 55 minutes in the evening. The tigers have access to the trail for 65 minutes in the morning, 45 minutes in the afternoon, and 34 minutes in the evening. Who has more trail time? How much more?

Lions access to trail=  $35+65+55=155$  minutes  
Tigers access to trail= $65+45+34=144$  minutes,  
So  $155-144=11$   
Lion has more trail time by 11 minutes.

## William Shakespeare

William Shakespeare was Born on or about 23<sup>rd</sup> April 1564 in the house preserved as his birthplace in Henley Street, Stratford-upon-Avon. The record of his age in the register is on 26<sup>th</sup> April.

Contrary to impressions given in some of the older biographies, Shakespeare came from good middle-class family on both sides. His mother, Mary Arden, was one of the eight daughters of a substantial farmer of Wilmcote, where the Arden farmstead may still be seen, his father, John Shakespeare was a prosperous and respected tradesman, who took an active part in wealthy affairs.

William was the eldest son and third child of the marriage and therefore took on several responsibilities, including helping his father.

One day while doing an errand for his father with his young brother Edmund, he stopped in the local market to buy something. His brother slipped in the mud and was helped to his feet by a young woman whose name was Anne Hathaway. She was a country girl who lived a few miles from Stratford in a little village called Shottery. William and Anne soon fell in love and were married in 1582.

They started their married life in the family home in Henley Street, but unfortunately Anne found it difficult to get on with her mother-in-law Mary. Mary had always thought that her son could have chosen a more educated wife.

Early Life: Galileo was born in Pisa, Italy. He grew up with his brothers and sisters during the Italian Renaissance. His father was a famous musician, and a music teacher. When Galileo was 10, his family moved to Florence, Italy. When he was in Florence, he started his education at the Camaldolese monastery. He was a good musician, and a good student. He wanted to become a doctor, so he studied medicine at the University of Pisa in 1581.

Scientist: When he was at the university, he started to like math and physics. He started his scientific discoveries at the university with a lamp swinging back and forth. At the time, this didn't agree with the science principles. In 1585, Galileo left the university to become a teacher. He experimented with different materials. He described their movements using equations. He invented the hydrostatic balance.


## LOCATION




# Theatre Live - At Home!
