### About the Dorm

SCLA offers housing to students who wish to enjoy our convenient on-campus accommodations with lakeside views.

### Amenities

- 152 beds, three floors, six gender-specific wings
- Secured access to dorm entrances and rooms
- Fully-staffed cafeteria in dorm building
- Student lounge and kitchenette in each wing

### Location

St. Croix Lutheran is located in a residential park-like setting in the suburb of West St. Paul. It is five blocks-walking distance from a variety of stores and restaurants and 15 minutes from the Minneapolis/St. Paul Airport, the Mall of America, and the Twin Cities of Minneapolis and St. Paul.

### Supervision

Students are supervised by a number of SCLA faculty and staff, including the following:

### Activities for Dorm Residents

On weekends, students are given the opportunity to participate in a variety of fun activities like ski trips, concerts, sports events, and cultural activities. Shuttle transportation is offered for weekly church services, shopping trips to the mall and traveling to the airport.

### Junior Boarding School

SCLA's Junior Boarding Program allows young students to become part of a diverse community that provides them the support they need during their middle school years. Students grow in social skills, organizational habits, and self-reliance, and are gradually able to take on more responsibility and leadership. Dorm supervisors provide a safe and nurturing environment that emphasizes a family atmosphere, emotional development, spiritual growth, and prioritized study time.
