Covid 19 Travel Alert

In light of the travel advisories enacted by the State of New Jersey that now apply to 31 states (see list below), the District is asking parents and staff to organize their travel plans accordingly. We have been advised by local health officials that students and staff who travel to one of the 31 states must self-quarantine for a full 14 days prior to starting school. A negative virus test does not supersede the quarantine period, so students or staff will not be able to attend the opening day of the school year if they return from any of these states after September 1.

The same travel advisory applies to student athletes and students in co-curricular activities, such as Band. Any student who travels to one of the 31 states listed below must self-quarantine for a full 14 days before returning to a practice or training session with other students or staff members.
