UNIVERSITY OF DETROIT JESUIT HIGH SCHOOL AND ACADEMY

- The new school day will run from 8 a.m. - 3 p.m.
- Students may engage daily class instruction in school or at home (more information on page 2). There is flexibility to move between the school and home models depending on family needs and circumstances.
- Six out of eight class periods will meet every day for 45 minutes each. All eight class periods will meet six times in an eight-day rotating cycle.
- Schedule includes 10 minutes between periods for passing, sanitizing, and transition.
- Schedule includes a daily 90-minute block for homeroom/lunch and formation/activity periods.
- Schedule applies during MI Safe Start Phases 4 and 5, and in Phases 1-3 (but all remote).
- Due to limits to classroom capacity for social distancing, some, but not all, classes will rotate between live instruction in the classroom with the teacher, and live instruction by the teacher broadcast to another classroom with a prefect. Based on family circumstances and medical needs, students may engage in remote instruction daily from home. Remote instruction will include live connection with the teacher.
- Class periods may have both synchronous and asynchronous components.
 - **Synchronous:** Class period time for live, real-time connection and engagement with ALL students, in classroom and remote, to take attendance and introduce learning activities.
 - **Asynchronous:** Class period time for students to work independently from teacher (no cameras) on a prepared lesson/assignment/activity/group work.
 - The proportions of synchronous and asynchronous learning may vary from day to day. A portion of every day's instruction will always be synchronous. The rest of the class may be completely synchronous, completely asynchronous, or some combination thereof. Alternatively, the teacher may engage part of the class synchronously (whether live or remote) while the other part of the class engages in asynchronous activities. This is no different than teacher practices prior to the pandemic.

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LIVE (IN PERSON) INSTRUCTION

- Instruction in the classroom in person with the teacher.
- Students and teachers are required to wear masks, unless there is an exception supported by medical documentation.
- Students will be feasibly socially distanced in the classroom with Plexiglas partition on their desk or learning space.

REMOTE (LIVE-BROADCAST) INSTRUCTION

- All classrooms will be equipped with high-quality cameras and microphones.
- Students will connect to classes directly using Zoom videoconferencing.
- Students will follow the same daily six period schedule as if they were in the building in person.
- Students will be able to connect to homeroom and formational period programs and with some cocurricular activities/club meetings.
- Students will be able to connect to classes remotely from home or within the school building if they are in a remote group rotation.
- If Michigan moves back to Safe Start phases 1-3, then teachers will engage in the schedule from the building or their homes. All students will follow the schedule from home.

FORMATION PERIOD

- This block of time is for daily supervised student activities and programs outside of classroom instruction.
- During formational and extracurricular periods students will participate in a menu of key supervised activities outside of academic class periods. This will include:
 - academic support programs and teacher office hours
 - socially distanced outdoor intramural or physical activity
 - student clubs and extracurricular activities
 - planned school, class or small group liturgies, prayer services, faith sharing, and reflection
 - planned programs on diversity and inclusion
 - planned programs for students led by the School Counseling and College Counseling teams
 - planned programs on social and emotional learning

HOMEROOM / LUNCH TIME

- Students will meet at this time to engage in grade level homeroom business.
- Students will eat lunch in their homeroom classrooms.
- QUEST, the school's food service provider, will provide preordered grab-and-go food options for students.
- When weather permits, students will eat lunch outside on the backfield socially distanced.
- Two homerooms will rotate each day to eat lunch in the cafeteria to allow for mixed socialization.

PASSING / SANITIZING / TRANSITION TIME

- Time is scheduled for staggered and socially distanced transition between classes, sanitizing desks before class period, and teacher connection with remote student group.
- Students will be required to stay to the far right and socially distanced in hallways when passing from class to class. Signage and markers will indicate this requirement.
