



Dear Eagle Hill Families,

We are working hard on confirming our plans for returning to campus and expect to share the full plans with you next week. In the meantime, I wanted to share some important information with you.

School Opening:

Given the need to bring all cohorts to campus at separate times for orientation, and the need for increased COVID-19 training for faculty and staff, we will take full advantage of the state's reduction of the required number school days from 180 to 177 and use two of these days to create a safe and efficient orientation schedule.

- The first day of school has been changed to Wednesday, September 2nd
- Orientation for ALL Upper School students will be on Monday, August 31st
- Orientation for ALL Foundations students will be on Monday, August 31st
- Orientation for ALL Lower School students will be on Tuesday, September 1st

School Supplies:

Due to current restrictions, students may not share school supplies. Attached below this letter are the supplies required for students in each division. Please be sure to mark your child's supplies with their name so that they can easily identify their belongings.

PPE Requirements:

As we mentioned in our last town hall, the State of Connecticut is requiring all students and faculty to wear a mask or face covering, that covers both the nose and mouth, when inside buildings. This will be a requirement that will be enforced to help significantly reduce the risk of spreading any illness. If you would like to discuss remote learning options, please feel free to contact your division head, Tom Cone, or me.

Travel Restrictions:

As you plan travel over the summer, please be aware of the requirement to quarantine if you have traveled from certain states. At your scheduled orientation, you will be asked to confirm your recent travel itinerary and affirm your child(ren) have, if necessary, been in quarantine. As of July 21st, traveling in the following states will require you to quarantine for two weeks upon return to Connecticut or New York. This list changes weekly and will be updated as necessary.
