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Dear Parents/Guardians,

July 13, 2020

We wanted to take the opportunity this week to update you on some of the health and wellness pieces of our reopening plan, as well as to share a summary of the results of the parent survey. The health, wellness and safety of our students, faculty and staff is central to the protocols we are developing in anticipation of the fall reopening of school. Some of the protocols are ones that you are very familiar with such as hand washing for 20 seconds, coughing into your elbow, avoiding touching your eyes and nose and staying home when you are sick. Some protocols and expectations will be new to your children such as the social distancing and the wearing of a cloth face covering.

As many of you are aware, we have been asked by the State Department of Education to incorporate in our plan that everyone wear a cloth face covering or mask during the 2020-2021 school year. We understand how foreign this is for everyone, including us, and how difficult a task this can seem. Like any new task, it needs to begin slowly and develop with practice over time. Some suggestions to get the students interested in a mask may be to have a mask made for a favorite doll or stuffed animal. Allow your child to decorate their own mask or pick out a mask of a favorite superhero. A parent/ guardian modeling the wearing of a face covering or mask is also helpful. Have them practice not touching the front of the mask once it is on and comfortable. Remember, a mask must cover the nose and mouth completely.

The plan will include mask breaks throughout the day with social distancing as we all will need a safe mask break during the day.

If you have any concerns about your child wearing a face covering or mask, please contact your pediatrician or healthcare professional.

There is so much value in having in-person interactions. We have missed seeing your children these past months. We are working on ways that lower the risk and increase the safety for everyone to return. Face cloth coverings, social distancing and hand washing are the three key components to that plan. Our goal is to have the students healthy, safe and ready to learn.


Preliminary Parent Survey: Fall Reopening


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What grade is your child entering for the 2020-2021 school year? PLEASE ONLY MARK ONE ANSWER.




Do you plan on sending your child to school on site in the fall? 497 responses




How likely are you to send your child to school in the Fall? 154 responses
