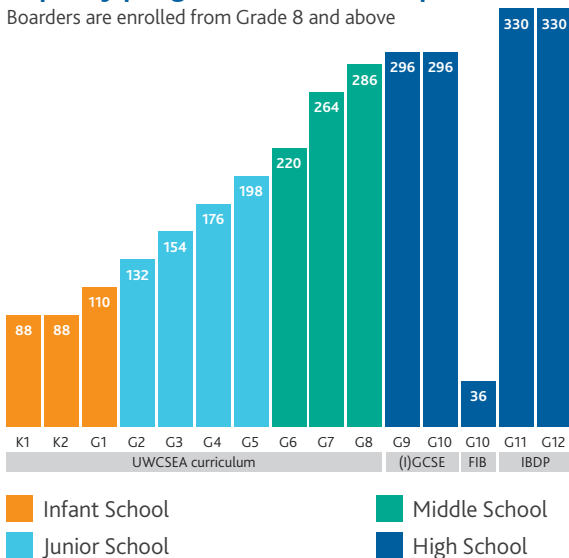

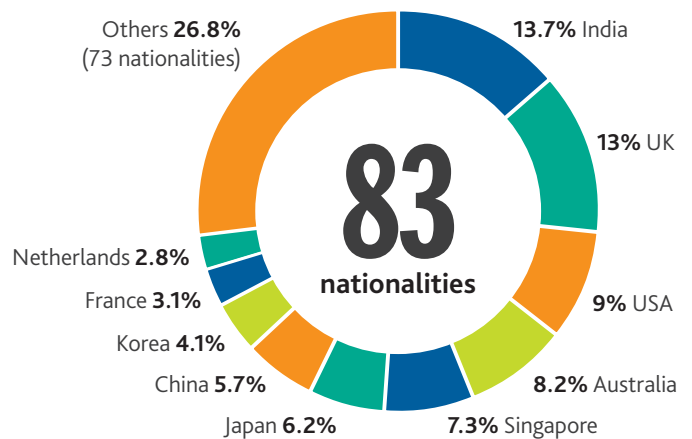

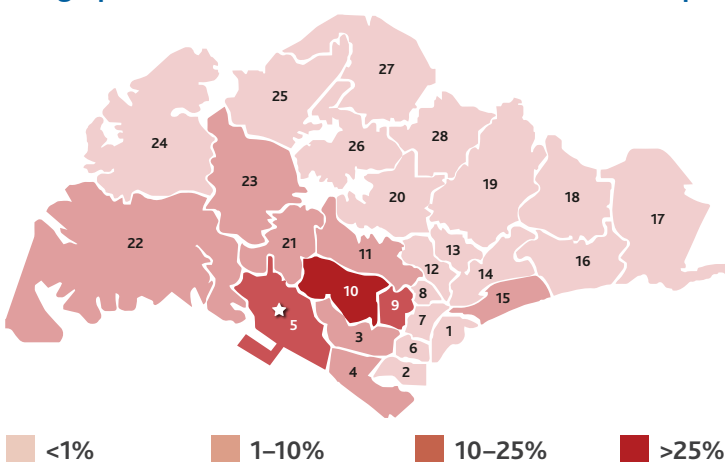
Nationalities at Dover Campus

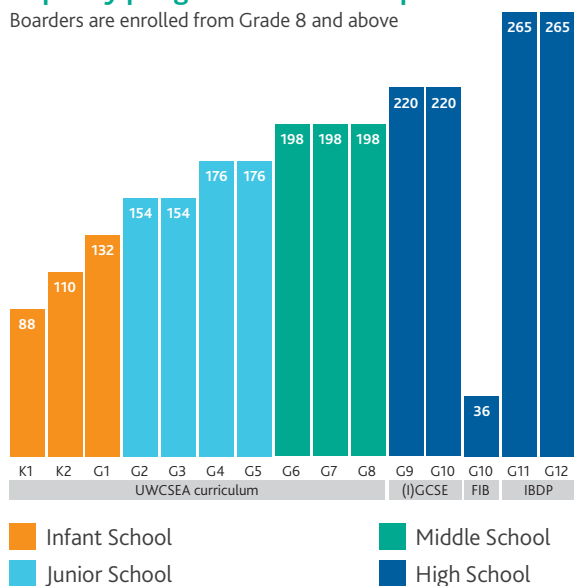

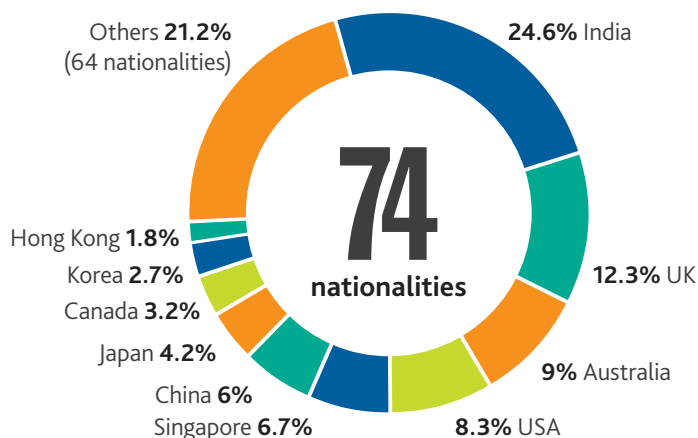

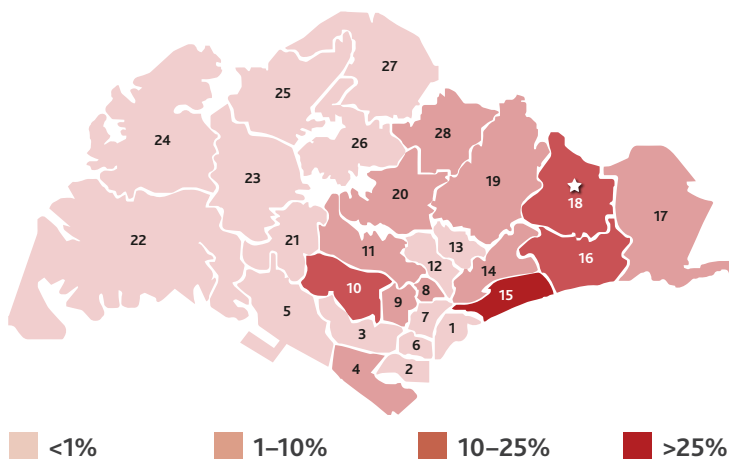
