

# SCE and FES Enhanced Model Restart Facts



The following information is to update you on questions you may have for the start of school for Steen's Creek and Florence Elementary. Please note that RCSD has allowed all zones to plan for the size and need of their building.

## **Social Distancing:**

- Students will be asked to wear a mask during transitions. When students are seated and social distanced from others, they can mask down. Students are responsible for bringing their own mask and having a clean one for the start of each day.
- Classrooms have been adjusted to help with distancing. Extra furniture has been removed from the rooms to help with spreading students out. Carpets have been moved and students will be provided their own stadium cushion to maintain a safe distance.
- Students will continue to walk in a line as they transition at a safe distance.
- Students work area will be spaced as much as possible.
- Students will use their own supplies and materials. There will be no sharing of materials.
- Visitors and guests will be strictly limited access to the building. Please call the school office prior to any needs or situations that would need our attention.
- Due to the current situation there will be no guests or parents allowed to attend lunch, parties, etc.
- Meet the Teacher will not be in person for 1<sup>st</sup>-5<sup>th</sup> Grade. Teachers will send an email invitation to set up a meeting time. Kindergarten Meet the Teacher will be done by appointment and teachers will email parents their time. You must have all residency and Snapcode enrollment completed to receive an email invite. Please call the school office if you have questions.

- Teachers and staff will have access to cleaning and disinfecting supplies at all times.
- All conferences will be scheduled and handled through Zoom. If you would like to set up a conference, please contact your child's teacher.
- K-2 students will be issued an iPad and 3-5<sup>th</sup> students will be issued a Chromebook. These will be assigned as soon as the district receives funds. Families without *internet access* will need to let their teacher know so that accommodations may be made in the event we are distance learning before the devices are issued.
- FES and SCE have a limited number of square footage in classrooms and other related obstacles, therefore social distancing will be maintained to the greatest extent possible.

## **Activities:**

- Students will have recess and enrichment classes (*library, music, PE, etc.*)
- Breakfast – will be grab and go- students will go to the cafeteria get their breakfast and eat in their classroom.
- Lunch – students will go through the line to get their tray and eat in their classroom adhering to distancing guidelines. Lines will be cleaned after each class.
- Students will wash their hands frequently throughout the day and areas will be sanitized several times a day.
- Extra-Curricular Activities such as Kidz Art and after school tutoring will not be held in the building this year.
- 2<sup>nd</sup> Grade and 5<sup>th</sup> Grade Honor Choir will not be held at this time and will be reassessed throughout the year.
- School Music programs and field trips will not take place due to the current restrictions.

## **Arrival and Dismissal:**

- Arrival times will not change.
- Car Riders- students temperature will be checked before they exit the car to enter the building. A temperature of greater than 100.4 will not be allowed in the building and students will have to be fever free for at least 24 hours.
- Bus Riders- will be required to wear a mask. Student temperatures will be taken upon arrival. Students with a temperature of greater than 100.4 will be escorted to our isolation room for parents to be called. Parent/Guardian must pick up the student immediately.
- Breakfast students will pick up their grab and go breakfast and eat in the classroom upon arrival.
- Dismissal- Students will be required to space apart and encouraged to wear their mask while waiting for pick up. Bus students will be spaced as they walk to their bus (mask will be strongly encouraged while walking to the bus and required upon entering the bus).
- Please note that arrival and dismissal times may be adjusted, and procedures may be changed throughout the year depending on the current situation.
- All transportation changes need to be sent through the student or faxed before 1:30pm to ensure the change will be made and verified.
- We will require self-screening for employees, students, and parents for COVID19 prior to coming to school. (*please see the RCSD Restart plan for self-screening questions*)
