


PHASED B **RE-ENTRY &** TRANSITION PLAN **FALL 2020**





PHASE I AUGUST 17 – SEPTEMBER 11

Two week orientation with limited students each day, then remote for two weeks

- Orientation Week 1 & 2 (All grade levels PK-13)
 - <u>Week 1</u>: Divide each class into two groups (A, B); each group comes two days per week (A group comes on Monday and Tuesday and B group comes on Thursday and Friday); Wednesday will be a remote day for all (AA, remote, BB)
 - Orientation to Teacher/Classroom, Back to School, Learning Management Platforms
 - Provide parent/teacher training during each student's assigned day (face to face or remote)
 - <u>Week 2</u>: Same groups as previous week; same schedule
 - Focus on questions, address misunderstandings, provide feedback, provide student expectations and troubleshoot any problems
 - Provide parent/teacher training during each student's assigned day (face to face or remote)

• <u>Week 3 & 4</u>

- Kindergarten through Grade 13: Remote learning for all students
- Pre-Kindergarten: each class divided into two groups (A, B); each group comes two days per week (A group comes on Monday and Tuesday; B group comes on Thursday and Friday); Wednesday will be a remote day for all (AA, remote, BB)
- Students who receive 5 hours or more per day of Specially Designed Instruction will attend on the A/B schedule as described in Week 1



NEXT STEPS:

- August 25 Board Meeting: Review and Assess Current Situation within schools/community and make determination if on track for Phase II
- Potential Phase II Options (other options may be considered):
 - Continue Remote Learning for a period of time to be determined by the school board

<u>OR</u>

• Phase into an A/B Day Schedule for all students (option to do a staggered phase-in depending on student needs)

**As per the July 28, 2020 meeting, the school board has decided to meet to review plans and situations on a regular basis.
