CCHS enjoys the full use of a 63-acre campus and athletic facility which includes 29 classrooms, four science labs, two technology labs, a robotics room, a full-service cafeteria, a performing arts center, four athletic fields, four tennis courts, a football/soccer stadium, and a full-size gymnasium.

COMMUNITY PROFILE

Capital Christian High School is a commuter campus with students representing all areas of the Sacramento region. CCHS is proud to represent an academically diverse population and appropriately addresses all learning styles. The school's campus is located in Sacramento off of Highway 50 and embodies an ethnically diverse student body with a 40% minority population. Over 100 churches are represented by our student body and approximately 15% of students receive financial assistance. CCHS is certified through SEVIS to accept International students.

ACCREDITATION

Capital Christian High School maintains dual accreditation from the Western Association of Schools and Colleges (WASC) and the Association of Christian Schools International (ACSI). The current term of WASC accreditation is six years, through 2020.
