SCENARIO #1 — In-Person Learning

THIS IS OUR PREFERRED SCENARIO

Diligently Prepared Our Multi-layer Mitigations:

- Ongoing Covid-19 cleaning. EPA-approved, effective for up to 90 days

- Increased service and changing of HVAC filters
- Air purifiers in every classroom
- Study/instruction areas provided outside so classes can be taught in multiple sections
- Directional hallway traffic; use of multiple entries/exits

SCENARIO #1 — In-Person Learning

Multi-layer Mitigations include (continued):

- Staggered times for brunch/lunch/recess
- Cross-ventilation/fresh air wherever possible
- MULTIPLE daily cleaning/wipe-down of door knobs, desks, play equipment, lunch areas, bathrooms, common areas
- 50 wall-mounted refillable hand sanitizing stations in classrooms and common areas
- Supervised hand washing multiple times per day
- Individual use of pencils, pens, scissors, books, study partitions, glue sticks, folders and other personal school supplies; shared supplies will be wiped down after each use

SCENARIO #1 – In-Person Learning

Multi-layer Mitigations include (continued):

- Spread out desks, individual desks, all facing forward
- "Cohorting" groups-- keeping students together with their class/group to minimize interactions
- Sneeze guard/protective guard between teachers and students
- Enhanced nurse station; expanded sick policy; additional teacher training
- Masks protocols for students and adults
- Possible additional mitigation measures for individual students
- Daily temp checks—still developing protocol
