- Instruction supplemented with online tools
- Gradual start for students
- Significant changes for health and safety
 - Masks
 - Staggered arrival, dismissal, class changes
 - Other program modifications

Monday, August 31 - AM (Grade 10), PM (Grade 11)

Tuesday, September 1 - AM (Grade 9), PM (Grade 12)

Wednesday, September 2 - All high school students in school

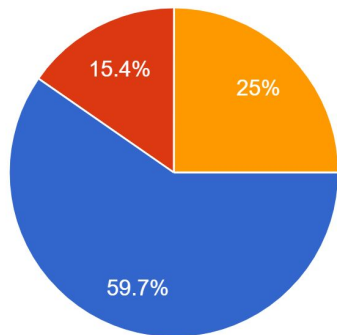

K-12 Hybrid Instruction

If the District needed to switch to a "hybrid learning model" to meet physical distancing guidelines (for example, in yellow phase) what would be your preference?

2,429 responses



- Students attend in school classes two days per week and learn virtually three days per week.
- Students attend in school classes for one week and learn virtually for one week.
- No hybrid model. Move to 100% virtual learning if required by physical distancing guidelines.

- Fully online/remote teaching and learning
- Synchronous and asynchronous
- Instruction supplemented with online tools
- Students remain with their assigned teacher and classmates

Remote vs Cyber Academy

Cyber Academy is selected by parents

Remote Instruction is declared by the District

- If we start back In Person or Hybrid, parents will CHOOSE the Cyber Academy if needed
- If we start back in Remote Instruction, all students will be in their regularly assigned classes. If we would then switch to In Person or Hybrid, parents could then CHOOSE the Cyber Academy

K-12 Cyber Learning Academy

- MTLSD Diploma
- Change between In Person and Cyber Academy on quarter (9 week) breaks

Synchronous vs Asynchronous

- Synchronous- existing or occurring at the same time
 - Live instruction
 - Small group instruction
 - Office hours
- Asynchronous- not existing or happening at the same time
 - Recorded lessons
 - Discussion board and groups
 - Shared documents
- Live Streamed Classes
