LSUHS COVID-19 RESPONSE EFFORTS





When the need was identified to expand community testing and increase access to testing available in areas our community most affected by the virus, LSU Health Shreveport was able to respond with a solution guickly by utilizing the Partners in Wellness mobile screening vans and capabilities of the Emerging Viral Threat (EVT) Lab established at LSUHS in March to address the critical need for more COVID-19 testing and research. The mobile testing effort was focused on reaching communities that are generally underserved and affected by COVID-19 at a disproportionate rate. It was important to meet the needs of these communities with free testing at easily accessible locations with a convenient drive up testing process. Community testing has been made possible due to LSU Health Shreveport's long-standing partnerships with Federally Qualified Health Centers (FQHCs) across north Louisiana, financial support from Caddo Parish Commission and corporate donors like Inferno Manufacturing Corp. and U.L. Coleman Companies, logistics and safety oversight by the Louisiana National Guard, and additional support from medical providers and several organizations, churches and businesses in our community.


