

How to set up your home learning environment



The following is a list of suggestions to set a specific learning environment in your home. Establishing a clear area in your home helps students know this is their work time and work area. This allows students to positively attend to virtual learning and also allows them to take a break physically from the space. These are important processes to establish a routine at home for virtual learning. We will provide you with some schoolwide rules to post in your child's learning area. Please take the time to reinforce the following with your children as our teachers will be doing the same during the first few weeks of school.

- Designate a specific area in your home for virtual learning/schoolwork.
- Eliminate all distractions as best you can with audio and visual and allow for a quiet individual workspace.
- Set up a desk/table and chair with a school-issued laptop and charge it every night.
- Do not eat or drink in the area in which you are working. Save these experiences for a personal break physically away from your workspace.
- Keep your child's backpack, textbooks, and all materials in this designated location.
