

Transaction of Business

The Board shall rely upon the Superintendent to recommend policies for adoption and to administer policies enacted by the Board. Such policies shall be broad enough to indicate a line of action to be taken by the Superintendent in meeting a number of problems and jobs. Application of such policies to individual problems and jobs is an administrative function to be performed by the Superintendent.

1. The Board shall transact all business at a legal meeting of the Board.
2. The Board shall act as a whole entity, except that a committee created in accordance with these Bylaws may act on matters before it in conformity with the committee's purpose or charge.
3. Individual members shall make no commitments for the Board or issue orders for the Board, except when executing an assignment delegated by the Board.
4. The Board shall concern itself only with broad questions of educational policy, and not with administrative details of the District's operations.
