

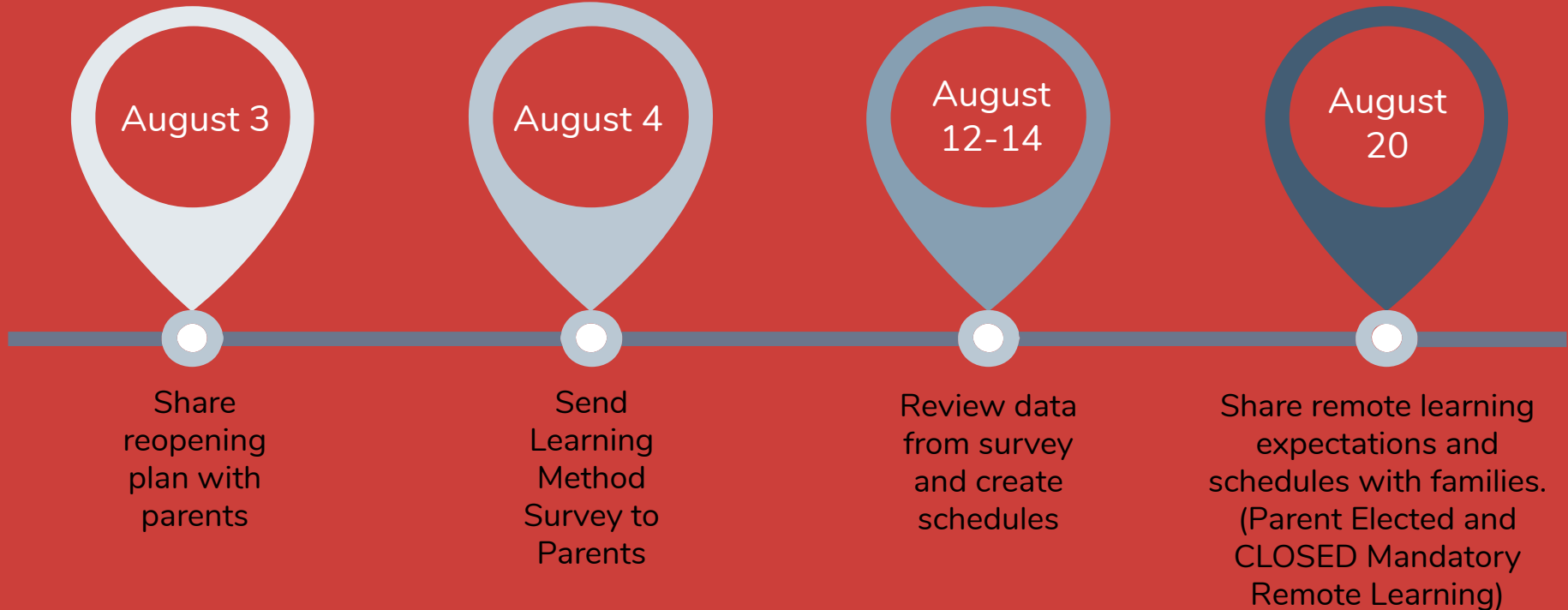

Assumptions

1. We will hold school in some capacity throughout the pandemic.
2. We will not have more money or resources than we currently do.
3. Some families will not want/be able to have their student attend school until effective treatments or a vaccine is available.
4. Many parents will not be able to supervise their children during the day at home.
5. Child care options for families will be limited.

Health and Hygiene



Face Coverings/ Protective Barriers

- Staff and students are **REQUIRED** to wear face coverings on district property and on the bus.
- 2 cloth face coverings will be provided to each student.
- Clear partitions may be placed in high traffic areas and in some classroom settings.



Hand Washing and Sanitizing

- Hand sanitizer stations will be located in hallways and on buses.
- Hand Washing routines will be part of normal routines.
- Rooms and buses will be sanitized at least once daily.



Drinking Fountains/ Water

- Drinking fountains will be turned off
- Bottle filling stations will remain on.
- Students will receive a water bottle.

Health and Hygiene



At Home Pre-Screening

- Parents are expected to Pre-Screen students for symptoms
- Report student absence to the school office.
- Parents should keep students home for:

- A fever > 100.4 without medication
(Do not give Ibuprofen to your child before sending him/her to school)
- chills,
- cough,
- shortness of breath/difficulty breathing,
- fatigue,
- muscle/body aches,
- headache,
- new loss of taste or smell,
- sore throat,
- congestion,
- runny nose,
- nausea/vomiting, or
- diarrhea

Returning to School After Illness

- **Covid 19** - Students may return to school when cleared by their health provider or the Trempealeau County Health Department
 - Documentation will need to be provided
- **Other Illness(es)** - Students may return to school when they have not experienced symptoms of illness for three days (72 hours)

BUILDINGS OPEN



Classroom Arrangements

Face-to-Face

- Desks will be arranged as far apart as practical based on available classroom square footage. In many cases they will be facing in the same direction towards the front of the room.
- Where tables are used and shared, plexi glass screens may be used to separate students.
- Non-instructional shared items will be removed.
- Instructional shared items will be cleaned between uses.
- Doors will be propped open if possible.

BUILDINGS OPEN



Lockers/Cubbies/Backpacks

Face-to-Face

Elementary:

- Lockers/cubbies will only be available during beginning and end of the day transitions
- Lockers/cubbies - only used for winter items and backpacks.
- All student's personal items go home each day

Middle/High:

- Lockers will not be used. Students will carry their belongings and school issued books in backpacks/bookbags.

BUILDINGS OPEN



Visitors to School

Face-to-Face

- No one from the public (including parents/guardians) will be allowed into the building while students are present.
- For all students who need to be picked up during the school day, parents will call the school office upon arrival to the building and the student will be released after the parent has been identified.
- Meetings with parents/guardians will be held virtually.

BUILDINGS OPEN Face-to-Face



Food Service

-
- Breakfast will be “grab & go” and will be eaten in the student’s assigned classroom or designated area.
 - Lunch will be served on disposable trays and students will use disposable utensils.
 - All condiments will be single-serve packets and will be stored and made available in each classroom.
 - All available spaces throughout the building will be used for eating, including hallways and common spaces.

BUILDINGS OPEN Face-to-Face



Transportation

-
- Parents are encouraged to drop off and pick up students to reduce number of students on buses.
 - Students must stay in their assigned seat for the whole ride.
 - Students must wear their face covering.
 - Hand sanitizer will be available for students entering the bus.
 - Students can only have one pick-up location and one drop-off location for the entire year.
 - Walkers need a face covering while on school property and should maintain social distancing to the greatest extent possible.

BUILDINGS OPEN



Face-to-Face

STUDENTS

- Wear face covering as soon as they exit vehicle
- Maintain social distancing to the extent possible.
- Do not congregate outside or inside the school.
- Wear face covering from school until in the vehicle.

Pick Up/Drop Off

PARENTS

- Must remain in vehicle at all times.
- If picking up during the school day, call office 608-323-3315 to retrieve your child.

BUILDINGS OPEN



Parents can choose to have their child engage in learning from home through live lessons.

Parent Elected Remote Learning

ATTENDANCE

- Must commit to remote learning for 1 trimester
- Taken daily/class period
- Required to log in during required time
- PK-4th -Adult required to be with child during remote instruction

INSTRUCTION

- Based on grade/course Power Standards
- Students must have access to reliable internet
- Use Google Classroom to access learning activities
- Students will follow **remote learning norms**
- Students will be held accountable to the district grading scale
- Students will follow their instructional class schedule.

LEARNING NORMS

- Video turned on.
- Microphone muted unless instructed to turn on or granted permission by the instructor to turn the microphone on.
- Chat NOT allowed between students.
- Logged in on time.

BUILDINGS CLOSED



Mandatory Remote Learning

Students will learn through live or recorded lessons following the closed remote learning schedule.

ATTENDANCE

- Taken daily/class period
- Required to log in during required time.
- Students not following attendance guidelines will be considered truant.
- Student **MUST** be logged in at the start of live classes and remain logged in during the whole class
- For students viewing recorded lessons, attendance is measured by the completion of the assigned formative assessment.

INSTRUCTION

- Based on grade/course Power Standards
- Use Google Classroom to access learning activities
- Students will follow **remote learning norms**.
- Students will be held accountable to the district grading scale.
- Students will follow the CLOSED Remote Learning instructional class schedule.

LEARNING NORMS

- Video turned on.
- Microphone muted unless instructed to turn on or granted permission by the instructor to turn the microphone on.
- Chat **NOT** allowed between students.
- Logged in on time.

Food Service

Mandatory Remote Learning

- Food service while buildings are closed has yet to be determined due to the lack of completed USDA guidelines
