On October 10, 2016, the SMSD Board of Trustees approved a resolution to explore the opportunity of SMSD becoming a District of Innovation

November 2016

SMSD Board of Trustees will hold a public hearing

On November 14, 2016, the SMSD Board of Trustees appointed a District of Innovation committee who will be responsible for developing a Local Innovation Plan.

January –

February 2017

A Local Innovation Plan will be developed

The SMSD District of Innovation Committee will develop a Local Innovation Plan. This process will include periodic dialogue and feedback between the DOI Committee and the Board of Trustees.

30 Day Public Review & Notification of Intent to Vote

The SMSD District Of Innovation Committee will post the completed plan for public review and comments. At the end of the 30 day posting the Board of Trustees will approve the plan.

April 2017

Texas Education Agency Commissioner Notified

Local Innovation Plan Timeline

August 19, 2019	SMSD district-level committee will vote to approve two new Innovations to amend the current Innovation Plan.
August 21, 2019-September 21, 2019	The amended Innovation Plan will be posted on the SMSD website for at least 30 days on the District of Innovation webpage.
August 21, 2019	The SMSD Board of Trustees will notify the Texas Education Agency of its intention to vote on adopting the amended LIP.
October 14, 2019	The SMSD Board of Trustees will vote to adopt the two amendments to the Innovation Plan.
By October 29, 2019	The SMSD Board of Trustees will notify the Texas Education Agency that it has adopted the two amendments to the Innovation Plan and will provide a copy of the final amended Innovation Plan to the TEA.
