
What type of flexibility?

- 4. Allow SMSD to fulfill its mission




Examples of DOI Exemptions


- Uniform school start/end date
- Opting out to balance instructional time in fall and spring semester
- Creative start date for students transitioning to middle or high school
- Teacher certification requirements
- Class size ratio




Examples of DOI Exemptions cont.

- Minutes of instruction
- Teacher/Administrator appraisal instruments
- Minimum attendance ("90% Rule")
- Professional Development
- Planning periods









