Dear Resident,

Many of you may be aware of the mandated improvements to the Vernon Water Pollution Control Plant by the State of Connecticut, Department of Energy and Environmental Protection. The Town of Ellington and the users of our collection system are 20% owners of this Plant and as so required to cover 20% of the cost related to the upgrades to the treatment facility.

Your latest sewer bill dated April 1, 2020 reflects a new flat rate of \$120 up from \$80 to all users of the system. Your sewer bill is then computed based upon your water usage and added to the base fee. The small amount of residents on wells will also see an increase of \$40 from \$270 to \$310. This increase is a direct relationship to covering the 20% of the cost for the upgrades to the Vernon Water Pollution Control Plant.

As we move forward in the upcoming years the Ellington Water Pollution Control Authority will need to insure that the users of the system continue to support the overall costs as they relate to the Town of Ellington maintaining our collection system and covering the Town's obligations to Vernon.
