Student Acceptable Use Agreement

I understand any violation of the Electronic Information Resources Contract may result in the loss of my user account and may result in further disciplinary and/or legal action. I agree to report any misuse of the electronic information resources to my site systems administrator. Attendance Policy

Any absence not cleared may be considered a truancy which may be accompanied by a fine.

Safe and Orderly Schools Policy

I have read and understand and accept identified parts of the Davis School District's Policy related to Safe and Orderly Schools Policy 5S-100 Safe and Orderly School Policy. In addition, I further understand the importance of safety for all students, and that if a student is suspected of violating the policy, they may be subject to suspension or expulsion from school, changed to another school, and/or referred to the police.

Bullying & Harassment

Central Davis Jr. High (CDJH) is committed to protecting its students from bullying and harassment. We believe all students have the right to learn and all teachers have the right to teach in a safe and harassment-free school. Bullying and harassment will not be tolerated and shall be just cause for disciplinary action, which, if severe or persistent enough, may result in removal from CDJH. I understand that I am not to bully or harass others while a student at CDJH and will do all I can to prevent this from happening at school. I understand that I can report any bullying or harassment issues confidentially to a teacher, counselor or administrator.

Credit Make-up

Central Davis Jr. High is adopting the Davis School District's Policy on junior high remediation and make-up. This means any student, 7th – 9th grade, who fails one or more core subject may need to make up this course. We may hold after-school and/or lunch time remediation classes during the first few weeks of the subsequent term. Transportation home is not provided.

Citizenship Make-up

Any 7th – 9th grade student who receives a “U” citizenship grade in any subject will be required to do 4 hours of community service and pay a \$5.00 fine. If you receive a “U”, you will need to visit with our In School Suspension (ISS) coordinator to pick up and return the Citizenship Make-up Form. Students who have U's not worked off and fines not paid by the end of the school year may have their yearbooks held. Please be responsible and respectful in class and follow school rules so you are not in jeopardy of receiving a “U” citizenship grade.

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Central Davis Junior High Locker Policy

For your own protection you must keep your locker combination confidential and keep your locker locked at all times. The school is not responsible for any loss of valuables and strongly urges students to leave valuables at home. If you need to have your locker combination changed, there may be a \$5.00 fine assessed. **Property Rights:** Lockers are school property and unannounced locker checks may be made. **Locker Condition:** Lockers must be kept in good condition. Broken or bent latches, dents, scratches, broken or missing hooks, vandalism, inappropriate decorations, writing on the locker, etc. may result in disciplinary action, which may also include loss of locker privileges and/or fines which must be paid before the last day of school. Report damage immediately. Interior or exterior decoration of the locker for birthdays, holidays, celebrations, etc. is *not* permitted.
