Whereas, Everett C. Paluska, settled in Ellington in 1945 and raised his family here until his death on November 17, 2001; and

Whereas, Everett C. Paluska served the Town of Ellington as Tax Collector from 1957 to 1971 and as First Selectman from 1975 to 1979 and served the State of Connecticut as Deputy State Tax Commissioner from 1971 to 1975 and Director of the Farmers' Home Administration from 1981 to 1990; and

Whereas, Everett C. Paluska, also served as Republican Town Chairman, Prosecuting Grand Juror of the former Ellington Justice Court and Probation Officer; and

Whereas, Everett C. Paluska was an active member of the Ellington Cemetery Association, serving in various capacities and as President from 1986 to 2001; and

Whereas, Everett C. Paluska devoted countless hours to the Ellington Congregational Church volunteering on many committees and boards and was a Deacon, Trustee and founding member of the Church Enhancement Committee; and

Whereas, Everett C. Paluska demonstrated extraordinary dedication to his family and community;

Now, Therefore, I, Michael P. Stupinski, First Selectman of the Town of Ellington, Connecticut, on behalf of all its citizens, and by order of the Board of Selectmen, do hereby induct Everett C. Paluska to the Ellington Wall of Honor in recognition of his outstanding contributions to the Town of Ellington.
