




Spring Lake Park Schools is using guidelines from the Minnesota Department of Education and Minnesota Department of Health to design learning models for the 2020-2021 school year that respond to local COVID-19 public health conditions. Throughout the year, we will be able to transition between models as needed. **All families have the option to choose full-time extended flexible learning (distance learning).**

Additional in-person days will be personalized to student needs 3 days a week of extended flexible learning (distance learning) To support flexibility in the time, place, and pace of learning, all courses will be built out online for 24/7 access | <p>School buildings are able to open following health and safety guidance.</p> <p>Grades K-12</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> 5 days a week in-person at school following health and safety guidelines for in-person learning |
