

WHAT TO PACK

MUST HAVE ITEMS	OPTIONAL ITEMS
Alarm clock Bath robe (Smedes residents require a robe that ties, not a wrap) Bedding (2 sets of sheets for one twin bed/Smedes requires XL sheets), pillows, mattress pad; extra blankets Cleaning supplies (laundry detergent, trash bags, and fabric softener) Desk chair Desk lamp Laundry basket School supplies (calculator, notebooks, pens, pencils, markers, highlighters, paper) Shower Shoes Small to mid-size storage bins with a snap-on lid to keep your food fresh; small drawers to double as a nightstand Toiletries Trash can and trash bags Hand towels (2), bath towels (2), wash cloths (2) Slippers to walk around the dorm in Water bottle Dress up clothes for formal dinners, professional days, and special events Flashlight and extra batteries	Bathroom rug Command™ hooks or strips to hang decorations on your walls Floor lamp Full-length mirror Mini-refrigerator Photos from home (or decorations to make your room more welcoming) Printer and paper Shower curtain (1 per suite) Sleeping bag (for overnight trips) Small rug Nightstand Debit card Plastic utensils and paper plates Camping chair to social distance in the quad or on dorm WHAT NOT TO PACK Microwave Hot pot, rice cooker, or other electronic devices used for cooking Heated blankets or heating pads (heating pads are available through the nurse) Over the counter meds (all medicine needs to go through the school nurse) Lava lamps Candles (they are in violation of fire code)
COVID-19 ITEMS Hand sanitizer Sanitizing wipes, such as Lysol or Clorox brands 5-7 cloth masks, will be worn all day Thermometer: non contact infrared temporal or temperature taking watch Disposable gloves (used for cleaning)	Bed Risers Decorative items that will hang from ceilings (lanterns, string lights, tapestries, etc.). These items are in violation of fire code. Valuables – large sums of money, jewelry, or other items of significant value Iron (available in laundry rooms on dorm) String lights of any kind (including strip lights that adhere to the wall)
