STUDENT RECOMMENDATIONS PROCESS

Many colleges will require additional teacher recommendations. Students are requesting that teachers take their time to complete these recommendations and occasionally the teachers may have to refuse for a variety of reasons. It is in the student's best interest to make this request at a time when he/she and the teacher can discuss the completion of the form, such as before or after school. Though some applications specify that a particular current subject teacher must complete the forms, others allow the students to choose the teachers. The student should select a teacher who knows enough information about him/her as an individual to describe him/her well.

For the teacher to present as strong a picture of the student as possible, it is extremely important that the student provide accurate information about himself. Students should complete the Student Profile Sheet and provide to the teacher(S). A personal resume including activities, home, etc. can substitute for the student Profile Sheet. At least <u>one month</u> before the applications are due, students should give teachers these completed forms and request letters through *Naviance Family Connection*.
