



The Greater Jasper Consolidated School Corporation has shared and updated the reentry framework as well as providing valuable information from sources such as the Department of Health and Governor Holcomb. We hope that everyone takes the time to visit the corporation website and thoroughly read the information provided before the start of the 2020-2021 school year.

The following are steps being taken by GJCS to ensure the safe transportation of students on school buses.

- School buses have been cleaned and disinfected prior to the start of school.
- Buses will be disinfected after each route.
- Bus windows will be opened as much as possible to air out buses.
- It will not be possible to social distance on the bus. To the greatest extent possible students shall be spaced on the bus to limit contact.
- Seating charts are required on the buses. Household members and students from the same bus stop will be assigned to the same or adjacent seats.
- Students are required to ride only their assigned bus.
- Face coverings are required to be worn by all students and drivers.
- If a student refuses to wear a face covering the following will occur:
 - Students will be given 3 opportunities to comply with mandatory face covering requirement on school buses.
 - First Offense – Warning - Call to parent.
 - Second Offense – Warning – Call to parent
 - Third Offense – Student prohibited from riding the bus for the duration of the academic semester.
- Students who are not defiant and simply forget their face covering will be provided one.

During these ever-changing times we will continue to seek ways to improve to ensure the safety of all students.
