

IMPORTANT Tuition and Student Fees



Our International Baccalaureate (IB) theater class will premiere performances of "Castaways (Varadas)" by celebrated Spanish playwright Itziar Pascual, translated by Phyllis Zatlin, on Feb.1, Feb. 7-8 at 7 p.m., in the school's black box theater, 1501 N. Oakley Blvd.

"Castaways" is the story of generations of women in the 20th century as they attempt to escape oppression and create a new life for themselves and their families. It features ten short scenes relating to the question of political exile and refugees in the aftermath of Spanish general and dictator Francisco Franco's authoritarian policies. In this unique production, each evening the actors will first perform "Castaways" in English then follow with "Varadas" in Spanish.
