In this unique production, the senior theater class will perform the play in both English and Spanish.




Varsity basketball is 3-3 at this point in the season. And our JV basketball team had a huge win over Golder College Prep to kickoff the basketball season!

Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship Apply for school year 2020-2021 today!

Applications for the Empower Illinois Tax Credit Scholarship for the 2020-21 school year will open on January 15th, 2020. Empower Illinois Tax Credit Scholarships are awarded on a first come, first served basis.

This year, the reservation form will be available on January 15th at 6:30 p.m. giving families time to enter their information before submission at 7 p.m. The reservation will have two pages. On page one you will enter basic information, such as parent name, student name, and contact information. On page two you will review this information and click submit. Only after clicking 'Submit' on page two will you receive your first-come, first-served timestamp.

On January 17th, you will be notified by email when part two of the application opens. To ensure accuracy you can complete this step whenever you are able. But we encourage you to submit your application before January 27th for the best chance at receiving a scholarship.

Tuition and Student Fees

Students with outstanding balances of over ten (10) days will be excluded from class on the 1st business day of the following month, which for the new year will be on January 7, 2020.

Students with an outstanding balance will not be allowed to participate in any school sponsored events (including prom and graduation), nor will they receive official school documentation (including transcripts).
