### Rabun County Schools Lunch Order Form

This form is to be used to order lunch for our virtual students only. Children must be students of Rabun County School System and will be charged for the meal the same as they are for lunch during face to face instruction. Meals are \$2.00 for paid Primary/Elem Students, \$2.25 for paid Middle/High Students, \$4.00 for reduced students, and no charge for free students. A free and reduced meal application can be found online at [www.ezmealapp.com](http://www.ezmealapp.com) to apply for free/reduced benefits. You may purchase a visitor meal for \$3.85. Meals must be picked up daily between 12:30pm-1:30pm at the Rabun County Primary School bus loading area. Please stay in your car and a staff member will bring your meal to you. You may prepay for meals using [www.myschoolbucks.com](http://www.myschoolbucks.com) or by cash or check at the drive thru. Exact change is encouraged. 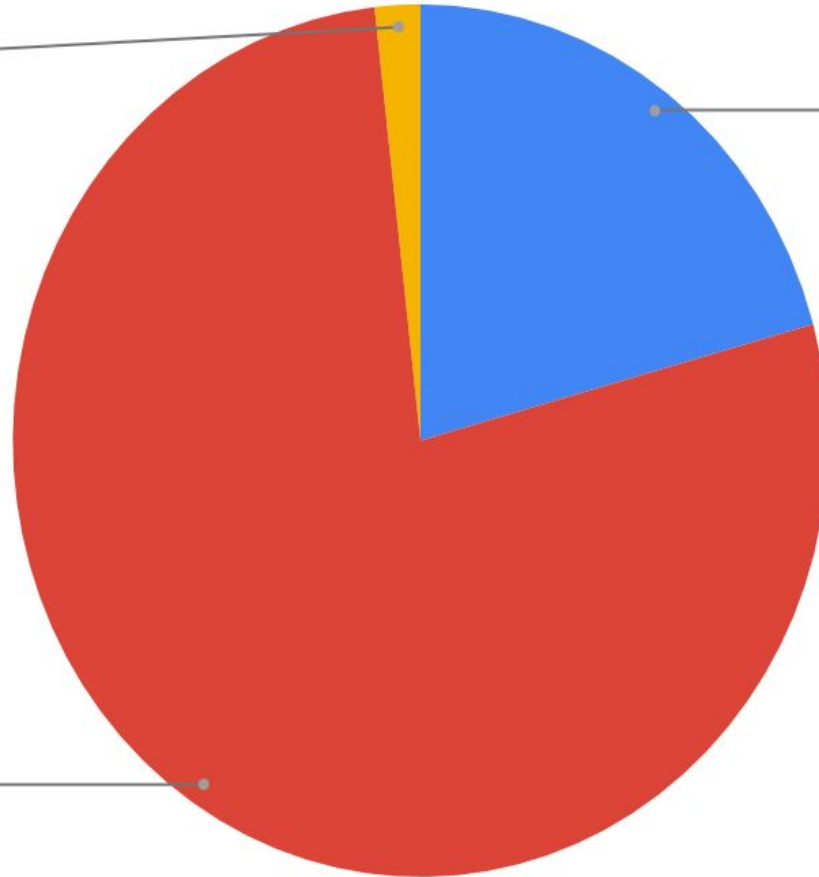

# Expectations



- Students and parents must attend a mandatory Virtual Learning orientation (face-to-face) before school begins.
- Students are making a commitment to remain in either Traditional Learning or Virtual Learning for the entire semester. Students may revisit their decision before the start of 2nd semester.
- Students must have access to high speed internet.
- Students will be required to follow a specific daily schedule similar to the Traditional Learning setting. Sample schedule on back.
- Classes will begin, with attendance being taken, at 8:00am daily. The same attendance policy will be used for Virtual Learning that is used in Traditional Learning including the reporting of truancy issues to the court system.

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# Expectations



- Student's virtual learning experience will be much different than it was during the Spring of 2020. Classroom expectations, deadlines, assignments, accountability, rigor, time, and grading will mirror those of face-to-face instruction.
- It is important to consider that if your child is not a fluent reader, is not comfortable with using technology, and is not comfortable participating in live video conferences, then significant adult assistance will be needed to help facilitate instruction in an online setting.
- Students will be required to complete all assessments in person (face-to-face) at their respective schools no less than twice a month.

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# Expectations



- It's important to understand that Virtual Learning requires a special set of skills and could have an adverse effect on a student's GPA/grades if they are not committed to the process required to experience success.
- Student elective offerings may be limited under the Virtual Learning option.
  - Check with Principals for more information. - HS mainly
  - Honors, AP, etc....
  - Check with your principal for further details

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# First Day Information



- **Primary and Elementary Schools**

- All K-6 virtual students will receive a phone call from their virtual teacher the week before school starts to schedule a Meet the Teacher appointment. These appointments can be face to face or virtual.
- During the Meet the Teacher meeting, you will receive your child's online schedule, be shown how to use the online Google Classroom platform, and receive classroom specific information.
- You will leave that meeting with everything you need to know to start school virtually on August 19th.

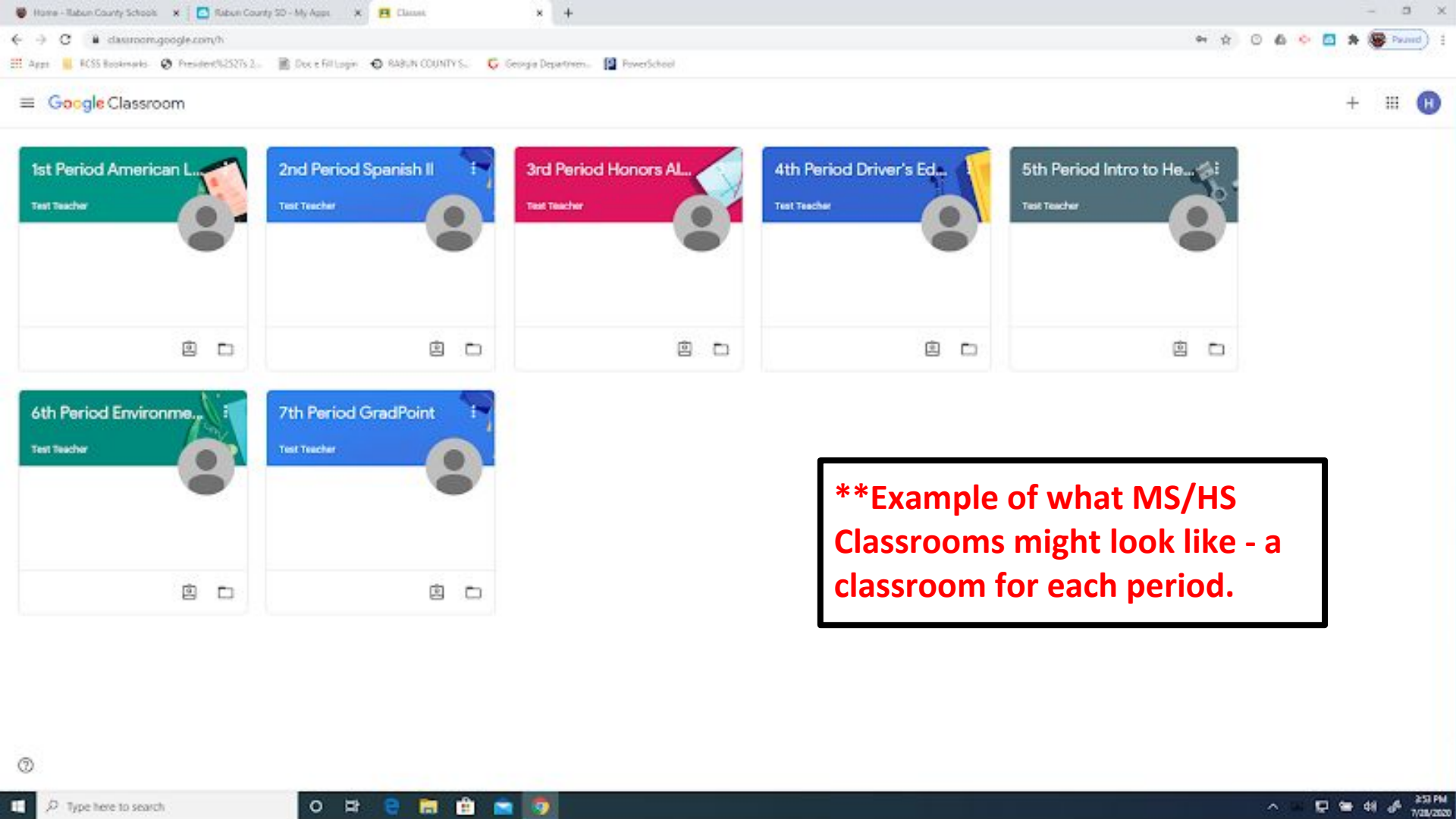

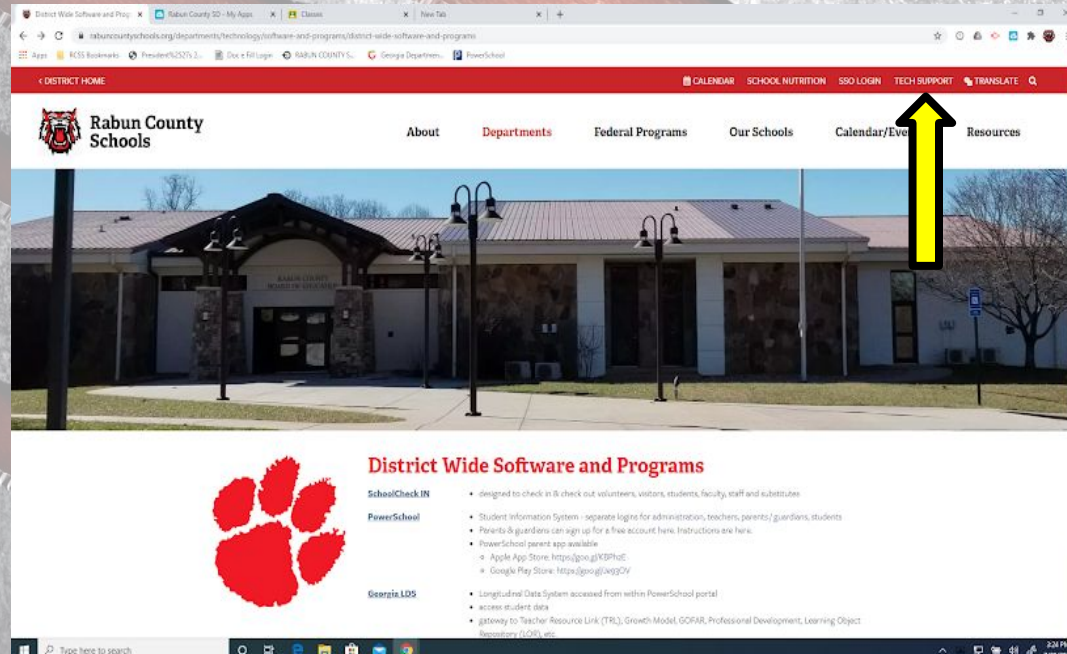
