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LA PORTE ISD UNVEILS FINAL PARENT DECISION SURVEY

District sets Aug. 12 deadline to choose face-to-face or virtual instruction, meal participation

La Porte Independent School District on August 4 posted its *FINAL Parent Decision* survey, from which parents and guardians will decide how children in their household will receive instruction on September 8 – the presumptive date that face-to-face learning will be allowed under state and local guidelines.

The *FINAL Parent Decision* survey is available through August 12, after which all students whose parents or guardians neither completed the survey nor contacted their campus with their preferred instruction method will automatically be enrolled in the face-to-face learning model.

The district will begin school virtually on August 19. Though responses to some of the survey questions, such as student technology needs, will be used to help ensure a seamless start to the (August 19 virtual) school year, parents and guardians will also opt for face-to-face or virtual instruction for the first grading period of the school year. The questionnaire also seeks information about student transportation needs.

The La Porte ISD School Nutrition Department has also posted a questionnaire to determine grab-and-go meal participation for the coming school year. It is also available through August 12.
