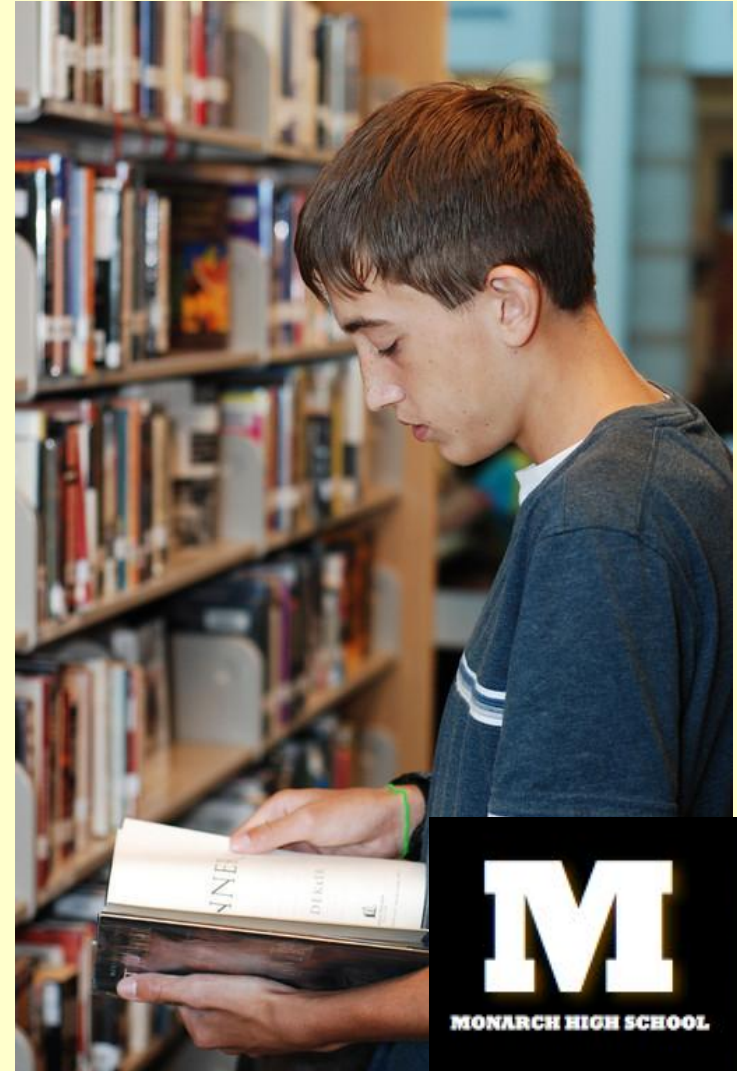

Advanced Courses More Options

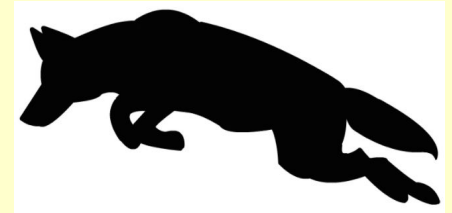


- **Advanced courses are available in most departments**
