
# FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL SCHEDULE







#### **GOLD DAY**

#### CLASSROOM SAFETY

# HIGH SCHOOL PASSING PERIODS

- Passing periods have been extended to eight minutes.
- Students may step outside for breaks if desired.
- Masks must be worn in the hallways during transition times.
- Hallways will be designed for a one-way directional flow, moving clockwise throughout the Micah Building to accommodate social distancing.
- When facing the Micah Building, the staircase to the left will flow in the upward direction. The staircase to the right will flow in the downward direction.
- If a student has a medical reason and cannot use the staircases, the elevator may be used.
- Only one person in the elevator at a time.

# HIGH SCHOOL LUNCH

Our lunch time routines will be altered in order to ensure social distancing. BRING LUNCH FROM HOME THE FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL.

- Bring a LABELED water bottle and/or snacks each day.
- No lunch time visitors.
- The coffee bar will be open with limited selections. Purchases may only be made through the Connect & Pay app, which is available in the Apple Store and Google Play. Lunches will be delivered to students at their designated lunch areas.

#### FIRST DAY AND BEYOND

# ARRIVAL CHECKLIST

#### MASKS

- Have on a mask as you enter campus.
- Staff and students are required to wear a mask, except when eating or exercising.
- Masks must be appropriate. Offensive or distracting masks will be replaced with a disposable mask and returned at the end of the school day.
- It is highly recommended that students keep extra masks with them in case they misplace theirs during the school day.

#### DISMISSAL AND PARKING PLAN

- Students will be dismissed from their 7th/8th period block using the exit doors closest to their classrooms.
- Parking is NOT allowed in front of the flag poles at any time during car lines.
- Please follow all traffic signs. The speed limit on campus is 8 mph. All school parking lots and car lines are cell phone-free zones until the vehicle is parked.
- Student drivers must register their vehicles by completing the <u>Online Permission</u>
  to <u>Drive Form</u>. A parking sticker will be issued for student vehicles.
