Initial Meeting

Our LDC specialist teachers are involved in the initial meeting, if there are any concerns that a child may need additional learning support. When meeting with the parents and child, the teacher will explain how the LDC Department operates. At Millfield Prep, time for additional learning support is built into the curriculum. The support offered, is decided following an assessment as part of the admissions process and is built into the letter of acceptance.
