3rd-6th Grades: Students will participate in an important library survey to guide Mrs. Therrell's decision making on lesson planning, Ebook purchases, and centers/STEM ideas. We'll also look at Mrs. Therrell's Virtual Library to help us understand where important library links and information are whether you are at home or school.

In addition to learning the ins and outs of our virtual library and reviewing our online catalog, Destiny, we'll also begin chapter read alouds in which students will be involved in in-depth reading, writing, and art activities that tie in with texts.
