DISTANCE LEARNING OPTIONS

- PK 2nd grade students have the option to participate in asynchronous distance learning.
- Students in 3rd and 4th grade have the option of asynchronous or synchronous learning.

MASKS

EXTENDED CARE

OUR EXTENDED CARE PROGRAM WILL OPERATE AS FOLLOWS:
