I will wash my hands frequently and thoroughly (for at least 20 seconds), especially after contact with surfaces and items in public areas; before and after eating; after coughing, sneezing, or wiping my nose.



I will act in the spirit of being Kind, Honest, Responsible, and Respectful, both on and off campus. I know that by following the safety and hygiene measures established by RCDS, I am helping to protect other Gators and myself from illness.
