# Unlocking the Locker Mystery



Student Locker Assignments

- All students will be assigned a locker
- Student will NOT be sharing lockers this year (until further notice)
- Students are expected to use a backpack or Trapper Keeper-type of binder as their "mobile locker"
- Students will not be allowed to "linger at lockers" between classes

#### **CDJH Dress Code**

\*\*This is the current CDJH Dress Code. The Dress Code is under Review by the school staff and community council. Any adopted changes will be posted here and announced to students. \*\*

## These guidelines are to be adhered during school or at school sponsored activities.

1. All students shall maintain themselves in clean and appropriate attire.

2. Students shall always wear shoes/sandals.

3. All shirts, tops and dresses are required to cover the student's entire upper torso, and to have capped sleeves (see-through material should be covered). Low necklines and backlines will not be allowed, and cleavage needs to be covered.



# CDJH Dress Code

### (Continued)

4. Length of skirts, dresses and shorts should be no shorter than three inches from the knee. *This applies to holes in pants, too.* 

5. No obscene, suggestive, or illegal words or pictures shall be worn on clothing (gang affiliation, drugs, alcohol, tobacco etc...)

6. Students will not be allowed to cover their heads in the building.

7. Pants that rest or hang below the waistline are prohibited (underwear should be covered).

8. Accessories with a potential to harm one's self or others are not allowed.

# CDJH Dress COde (Just two More)

9. Any attire, hairstyle or color, piercing (only allowed in the ear) or makeup which can be considered extreme and which brings undue attention to the student, disrupting the educational process, is not permissible.

10. School officials may permit or require students to wear certain types of clothing for health or safety reasons, or, in connection with certain specialized school-sponsored activities.

Students who violate the dress code will be expected to correct the violation and to review the school dress code. Students not in compliance with the dress code may be held out of class until they comply.
