



## 2020-2021 INSTRUCTIONAL PLAN FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

### How has Servite prepared to return to school for the 2020 - 2021 school year?

Servite conducted task force meetings to create an overall [Return to School Plan](#). After operational levels were identified, a team of administrators, teachers, and parents conducted an extensive review of possible schedules to fit each operational level to ensure academic and extra-curricular time is deliberately and strategically included in the overall student experience. Surveys from the Spring 2020 Remote Learning experience, along with information from our online summer school program, assisted in the development of an exceptionally structured Instructional Plan for the 2020-2021 school year. In addition to a detailed instructional plan, preparations include the following:

- Administration and teachers established best practices and protocols for a smooth transition from traditional learning to a distance learning or hybrid model.
- All faculty and staff members will complete a COVID-19 certification prior to the opening of school.
- All faculty members will participate in a Remote Educator Certificate program designed to support distance learning, student engagement, effective instructional practices, and strong relationships with students in a virtual or distance learning environment.
- All faculty members will welcome their respective students during class orientation days to establish a person-to-person relationship before beginning the school year.
- All students will receive training with respect to expectations and protocols in a remote or hybrid learning environment during their class orientation days.

### What is included in the Instructional Plan for the 2020 - 2021 school year?

Servite High School's Instructional Plan outlines detailed information about the four operational levels for the 2020 - 2021 school year. It also includes critical information such as bell schedules, student expectations, and the most current health and safety precautions for Servite High School. We remain committed to delivering an exceptional academic and student experience with safety and health at the center of each operational level.
