 - setting goals that reflect the most critical academic needs of the school

 - allocating School LAND Trust funds to support the SIP
- Advise, make recommendations, and partner with the school regarding school and district programs including:
 - the Child Access Routing Plan
 - safe technology utilization and digital citizenship
 - other issues related to the community environment for students
